

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPOSITION OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AND SHADE TREE ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, the Environmental and Shade Tree Advisory Board has provided guidance and information to the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen regarding issues of concern about the environment to residents of the Township of Aberdeen, and

WHEREAS, the Environmental and Shade Tree Advisory Board has sought to involve the youth of the Township of Aberdeen in its activities, and that students from Matawan-Aberdeen Regional High School have been extended the opportunity to be involved in an advisory capacity with the Board, and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen finds that the citizens of the Township of Aberdeen have continued to express an interest in serving as members of and fulfilling the duties and functions of the Environmental and Shade Tree Advisory Board, and

WHEREAS, the Township Council finds that in order to provide a role for both the citizens and the youth of the Township of Aberdeen in the ongoing duties and functions of the Environmental and Shade Tree Advisory Board, it is necessary to provide for an expansion of the current composition of the Board,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen that Chapter II, Administration, Section 2-21.4, the Environmental and Shade Tree Advisory Board, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

There shall be an environmental and shade tree advisory board known as the Environmental and Shade Tree Advisory Board of the Township of Aberdeen. The Board shall be composed of five persons and two alternates, who shall be appointed by the Township Council for terms ending January 31 of each year, the chairman of which is to be elected by a majority of the members thereof each year. The Board shall also consist of two non-voting advisory positions, to be open to students enrolled in Matawan-Aberdeen Regional High School, to be appointed by the Township Council to terms ending January 31 of each year.

All other provisions of Section 21.4 not inconsistent herewith remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
